

ELEVATION MONOGRAM INSTRUCTIONS

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MATERIAL USED:

- Embroidery Thread: Floriani Poly 40 weight
- Bobbin Thread: 60 weight bobbin poly thread.
- Stabilizer: Backing: Tearaway Medium
Topping: Tearaway Medium remnants (4 to 6 layers)
- Needle: Adapt to your fabric

Note: You can now buy your stabilizers and threads directly from us... please contact us with any questions.

Instructions:

Note: Test this monogram with 4, 5 or 6 layers of tearaway on top to determine which thickness is preferred for the project.

1. Hoop 1 layer of tearaway as backing and 1 layer of fabric.
2. Lay 4 to 6 layers of tearaway on top of your fabric. DO NOT stick the layers together.
3. Stitch the first color.
4. Remove the hoop from the machine. Tear away each of the layers of stabilizer, one at a time. It's very important to tear each of the layers one at a time and to tear away from the stitches without pulling the stabilizer from under the stitches to keep our thickness.
5. Place hoop on the machine and stitch the last color.

The objective of this technique is to reproduce, as much as possible, the look of the hand raised embroidery monogramming. Hoping that you will enjoy this new twist. Happy Embroidery!

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
